Our baseline year is 2020 and includes Scope 1, 2 and 3 emissions, calculated using the conversion factors provided by the Department for Energy Security and Net Zero (formerly BEIS). We ensure our carbon footprint is independently third-party verified on an annual basis to ensure alignment with the ISO 14064-3 standard and the GHG Protocol.

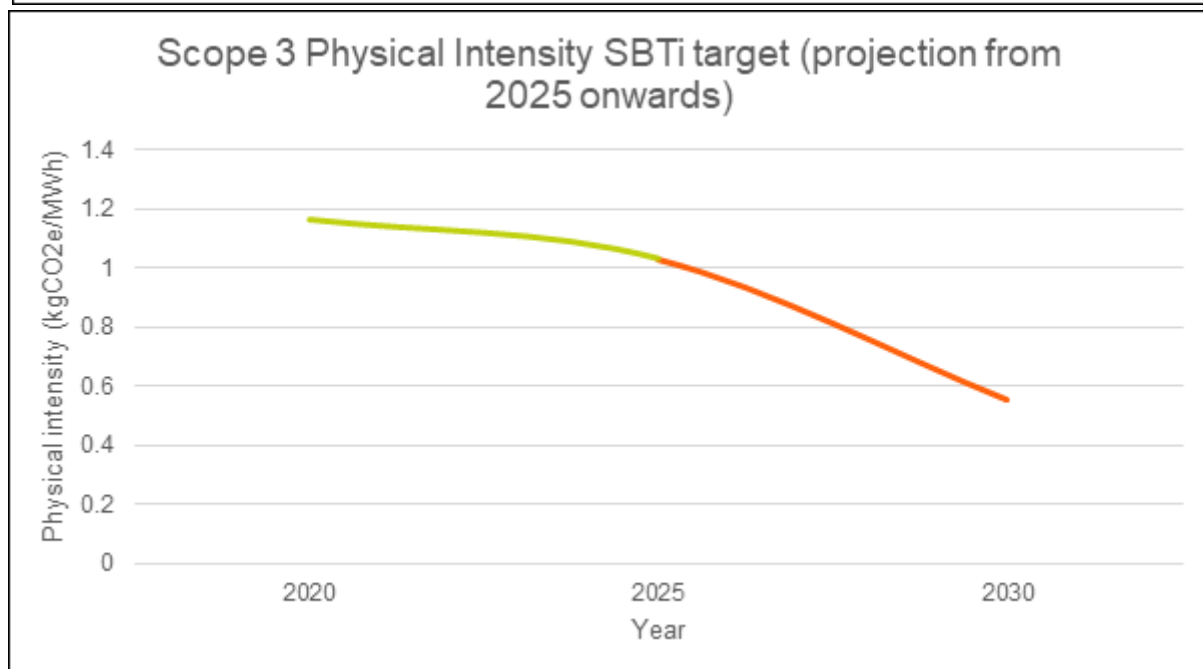
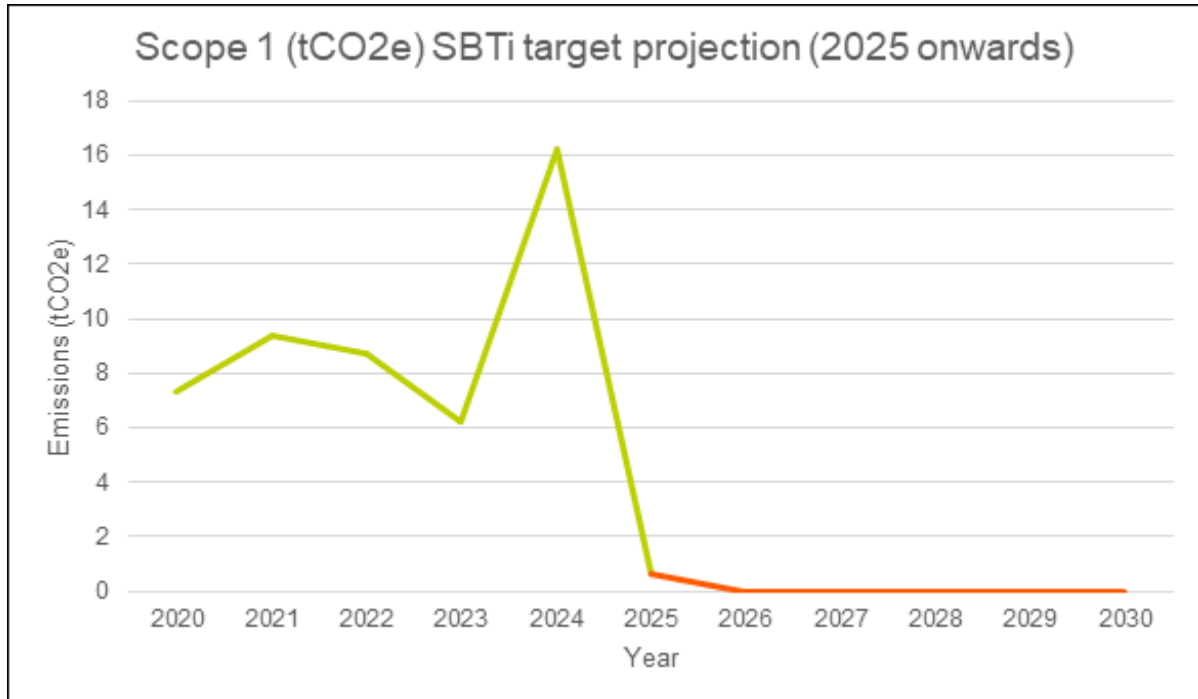
Emissions reduction targets

In 2023, Bryt Energy set and validated two near-term science-based targets with the Science Based Targets initiative's (SBTi) Corporate Net Zero Standard. This public commitment from Bryt Energy is to reduce absolute Scope 1 and Scope 2 greenhouse gas emissions 90% by 2030 from a 2020 base year, and to reduce Scope 3 greenhouse gas emissions 52% per megawatt hour (MWh) of renewable electricity* supplied within the same timeframe. The Science Based targets method aligns our emissions reduction strategy with the latest climate science and limiting global temperature increase to no more than 2 degrees Celsius.

The first graph below shows our absolute Scope 1 emissions since our 2020 baseline year up until 2025, and our projected Scope 1 emissions going forward until our SBTi target year of 2030. There was a temporary spike in emissions in 2024 due to a refrigerant leak at our previous office building, and since 2025 we have relocated to a new office which runs on zero natural gas and 100% renewable electricity.

The second graph shows our Scope 3 physical intensity emissions since our 2020 baseline year up until 2025, and our projected Scope 3 physical intensity emissions going forward until our SBTi target year of 2030.

Carbon reduction projects

Completed carbon reduction initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the **2020** baseline. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equate to **6.7 tCO₂e**, a **91.3%** reduction against the 2020 baseline and the measures will be in effect when performing the contract.

In 2025, Bryt Energy achieved its Scope 1 near-term science-based target of reducing absolute emissions by 90%. This was because Bryt Energy moved to a new office in Cornerblock, Birmingham, where our office is powered, heated and cooled by 100% renewable electricity and zero natural gas. The office move demonstrated Bryt Energy's commitment to our carbon reduction targets, as well as driving sustainability through the Silver SKA-rated office fit out. This ensured good practice measures were chosen across energy, carbon, waste, water, pollution, transport, materials and wellbeing to align our office with our values and ambitions.

Future carbon reduction initiatives

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Complete a supplier engagement project that looks to identify emissions-related hot spots within our supply chain and implement sustainable procurement measures, working with our suppliers to improve accurate reporting and reduce their emissions.
- Cross-functional collaboration across departments to embed carbon emissions trajectory and reduction targets into financial decision-making.
- Continue delivering effective employee engagement initiatives that aim to reduce employee emissions (Scope 3, Cat 6 & 7).
- Develop a Climate Transition Plan that encompasses the businesses' governance, strategy, risk and targets to deliver on carbon emissions reduction and sustainable business practices.

Declaration and Sign Off

This CRP has been completed in accordance with PPN 006 and associated guidance and reporting standards for CRPs.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for CRP and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard¹ and uses the appropriate Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting².

Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been reported in accordance with SECR requirements, and the required subset of Scope 3 emissions have been reported in accordance with the published reporting standard for CRPs and the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard³.
